### **Rules and Regulations**

- 1. Exhibitor will have to make entries online at <u>www.alnationalfair.org</u> under the participate link. Online entry deadline will be Friday, September 16<sup>th</sup> no substituting, changes, or late entries will be accepted. NO EXCEPTIONS!
- 2. Entry fee for the Alabama Boer Goat Show will be \$10 per animal until Friday, September 16<sup>th</sup>. Pen sizes are 4 ft by 6 ft. **NO TACK PENS WILL BE ALLOWED! NO REARRANING OF PENS! PENS are on a first come first serve basis.**
- 3. Upon receipt of entry, each livestock exhibitor will receive a complimentary 10-day wristband. All other family members will be required to purchase a 10-day gate passes for admittance to the Fair or a one-day pass (prices may vary daily). Passes will be sold at the Livestock Gate Entrance for \$25 each (children 5 and under are admitted FREE.) ALL passes (complimentary and pre-purchased) will no longer be mailed. They will be located at the Livestock Gate upon arrival. Pre-order competitor wristbands are on sale for \$20 when registering online.
- 4. Alabama Boer Goat Show is a sanction show by the American Boer Goat Association.
- 5. Classes will be provided for Percentage does, Full blood/Purebred does, and Full blood bucks.
- 6. All goats from out of state (Outside of Alabama) must be accompanied by a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection issued within 30 days of the show date by an accreditable veterinarian certifying that animals to be free of visible signs of contagious and/or infectious diseases.
- 7. The Species committee will check Certificate of Veterinary Inspection and inspect all animals in the barn from Friday, October 8th from 1:00 to 5:00 pm.
- 8. Registration certificates must be presented to the Species Committee for review prior to 5:00 pm on Friday, October 7th.
- 9. Each exhibitor must furnish their own watering containers. Community or common watering facilities are prohibited.
- 10. The fair will provide space and wood shavings for first bedding only. Hay, feed and additional bedding will be the responsibility of the exhibitor.
- 11. Exhibitor quarters must be kept clean. Exhibitors who fail to do so will be asked to remove their animals.
- 12. Animals will be release immediately after the show. Early release will need have the Species committee written approval.
- 13. Positively, NO Open Fires, charcoal fires, grills, cooking or food preparation will be allowed in the barns, pens, displays, or show areas.
