



The Alabama National Fair Livestock Program wants to invest in the future of agriculture by awarding an annual scholarship(s) to students who have participated in the livestock show(s).

The scholarship program is named after James C. “Jimmy” Dickey Memorial Livestock Scholarship; in appreciation of Jimmy’s love of and dedication to the Alabama National Fair, and his special interest in and love for the Youth Livestock Program.

Scholarship Guidelines/Requirements

- Applicant must be a U.S citizen and Alabama resident, exhibit good moral character and citizenship, and exhibit excellent academic potential.
- Must be scheduled to graduate from an Alabama High School (public, private, or home) during the 2017 – 2018 school year.
- Have made formal application to enroll with intent to attend an accredited, non-profit Alabama College, University or trade school in the fall of 2018.
- Complete and pass all necessary standardized test(s)/ requirements for graduation and have met the entrance requirements for the college or university for which the formal application has been made.
- All who apply for scholarship must participate in the 2017 Alabama National Fair Livestock Show as a Premier exhibitor and must compete in the Skill-a-thon Quiz, Judging, Showmanship, and exhibit an animal to qualify.

Selection Process

- Applications must be submitted electronically. Completed application must be received by the Oct 15, 2017, deadline for consideration.
- The Alabama National Fair Livestock Executive Committee will review applications and Premier Exhibitor awards and recommend winners to the Alabama National Fair Scholarship Committee for their approval.
- We do not discriminate on the basis of race, religion, national origin, color, sex, age, veteran status, or disability. It is our intention that all qualified applications be given equal opportunity and that selection decisions are based on the merit of the application.
- The senior that has applied for the scholarship with the top score in the Premier Exhibitor and meets other requirements will be considered for the award.

Receiving the Award

- Payment of \$1,500 for tuition will be made to the student (for the top boy and girl of the 2017 Livestock Shows) and the school. The student’s university will officially apply credit to student’s tuition account.
- Student and parents/guardians will be invited to an event formally recognizing scholarship winners. The award will be presented at the Kiwanis Club Lunch banquet in Montgomery, AL.
