- Contest is open to residents 18 years and older.
- Competitors must purchase a "Competitors Pass". See the Official Rules for more details.
- Recipe's must be on a 2019 Alabama National Fair Recipe Form and is due at the time of the contest. Recipes become the property of the Alabama National Fair, including editing and publishing rights.
- Competitors should create an original and tasty Italian dish. Prepare your dish at home and bring it fully cooked and ready to serve. Microwaves and stoves will be available to warm your dish if necessary. Preparation of your dish in the CLC kitchen is prohibited.
- For your convenience, you may register online at our website, [www.alnationalfair.org](http://www.alnationalfair.org), under the competition link. Follow the instructions on "How to make an entry". Deadline for online registration is Sunday, September 15<sup>th</sup>.
- Competitors may register/sign-in a maximum of forty-five (45) minutes prior to the scheduled start time of the contest.
- Registration/sign-in will close ten (10) minutes prior to the scheduled start of the contest. Competitors not registered/signed-in by that time will not be allowed to participate.
- Competitors must complete set-up by the scheduled start time of the contest.
- Judges decisions are FINAL.
