CLASS

1. Beans & Peas, 12 pods
2. Leafy Vegetable (cabbage, lettuce, greens, - one bunch/head etc.)
3. Fruit, exhibit of 4
4. Eggplant, exhibit of 4
5. Nuts (pecans, peanuts, walnuts, etc. – 1 pint)
6. Okra, exhibit of 8
7. Peppers, exhibit of 8
8. Root Vegetable (potatoes, carrots, onions, beets, radish, etc.) exhibit of 4
9. Pumpkin, exhibit of 1
10. Squash / gourds, exhibit of 4
