- Prepare your dish and bring it fully cooked and ready to serve. Microwaves and stoves are available to warm your dish if necessary. Preparation of your entry in the CLC kitchen is prohibited.
- Please bring your own Serving Utensils. (Knives, Spoons, Meat Forks, Cake/Pie Servers etc.)
- The recipe must be on an Alabama National Fair recipe form and is due at the time of the contest. Recipes become the property of the Alabama National Fair and the listed sponsor, including editing and publishing rights. The winning contestant’s name, photograph and recipe may be used for publicity and promotions (CLC Rule # 20-22).
- Competitors must comply with all CLC Official Rules ([www.alnationalfair.org](http://www.alnationalfair.org)).
- The contest is open to Alabama residents 18 years and older.
- Competitors **MUST** pre-register for this contest no later than Wednesday, October 1, 2025, at 1:00 p.m. Anyone not pre-registered will not be allowed to participate (CLC Rule #16).
- Competitors must purchase a “Competitors Pass” (CLC Rule #17).
- Competitors may sign in a maximum of thirty (30) minutes prior to the start time of the contest. Sign-in will close ten (10) minutes prior to the scheduled start of the contest. Competitors not signed-in by that time will not be allowed to participate.
- Competitors must complete set-up by the scheduled start time of the contest.
- Judges’ decisions are FINAL.
