RULES

- Exhibitors may only enter one (1) item into each quilting Class. Entry must fall into one of the listed categories/classes below.
- Quilts must be "Quilt Show Ready" (defined as being clean, free of animal hair, and free of odors).
- Quilts previously entered in the Alabama National Fair may not be re-entered.
- Quilts must have been either pieced and/or quilted by the exhibitor.
- A 3x5 card should accompany the entry identifying the (1) name of the pattern, (2) name of the individual(s) who pieced the entry, and (3) name of the individual(s) who quilted the entry.
- Entries will be accepted at the Creative Living Center on the following dates/times (No Exceptions):

<u>DIVISION 1 – MACHINE QUILTING – SINGLE QUILTER</u>

Entry may be hand or machine pieced but must be machine quilted.

Entry must be pieced and quilted by the same individual.

CLASS

- 1. **Applique Quilt** a technique where one or more pieces of fabric are attached to larger squares of fabric to create a pattern. Fabric can be attached by hand, machine or fused.
- 2. Holiday Quilt any Holiday, any design or pattern.
- 3. **Patchwork Quilt** a technique in which scraps of fabric are pieced together to make a block. Blocks are sewn together to make the quilt.
- 4. **Memory/Keepsake/Scrapbook Quilt** a technique where you take a collection of special quilt squares and piece them together to honor or remember special milestones, events, or memories.
- 5. Paper Pieced Quilt Either English Paper Piecing or Foundation Paper Piecing.
- 6. Quilts not Listed

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DIVISION 2 – MACHINE QUILTING – TEAM QUILTING

Entry may be hand or machine pieced but must be machine quilted. Entries in this division must be pieced/quilted by more than one individual.

CLASS

- 1. **Applique Quilt** a technique where one or more pieces of fabric are attached to larger squares of fabric to create a pattern. Fabric can be attached by hand, machine or fused.
- 2. Holiday Quilt any Holiday, any design or pattern.
- 3. **Patchwork Quilt** a technique in which scraps of fabric are pieced together to make a block. Blocks are sewn together to make the quilt.
- 4. **Memory/Keepsake/Scrapbook Quilt** a technique where you take a collection of special quilt squares and piece them together to honor or remember special milestones, events, or memories.
- 5. **Paper Pieced Quilt** Either English Paper Piecing or Foundation Paper Piecing.
- 6. Quilts not Listed

DIVISION 3 – HAND QUILTING

Items may be hand or machine pieced but must be hand quilted.

CLASS

- 1. **Applique Quilt** a technique where one or more pieces of fabric are attached to larger squares of fabric to create a pattern. Fabric can be attached by hand, machine or fused.
- 2. **Holiday Quilt** any Holiday, any design or pattern.
- 3. **Patchwork Quilt** a technique in which scraps of fabric are pieced together to make a block. Blocks are sewn together to make the quilt.
- 4. **Memory/Keepsake/Scrapbook Quilt** a technique where you take a collection of special quilt squares and piece them together to honor or remember special milestones, events, or memories.
- 5. Paper Pieced Quilt Either English Paper Piecing or Foundation Paper Piecing.
- 6. **100% Hand Quilted** (Pieced and quilted by hand).
- 7. Quilt Not Listed.
